Stock Analysis

- A good stock is less likely to receive bad news, less volatile
- A good stock has better chances for growth
- Volatile* stocks will have better premiums
- Bad stocks are difficult to trade covered calls with, and could have sustained selling periods



Fundamental Analysis

- Fundamental analysis is much like evaluating a house for an investment
- You take out all emotion and look strictly at the numbers to make sure it is a sound investment

- •P/E (TTM)
 - •Price divided by earnings
- Price to Sales (TTM)
 - •Price divided by revenue
- Price to Free Cash Flow (TTM)
 - •Price divided by cash flow per share

 - •Current assets divided by current liabilities
- Total Debt to Equity (MRQ)
 Debt divided by equity

DCF Analysis

- •Fair Value (Margin of Safety) •P = $E_1Q + E_2Q^2 + ... + E_NQ^N + E_NQ^N \times Q/(1 - Q)$
- •Using Future earnings to help determine a stock's current price

Three Things Make a Stock Move

- Fundamentals
 - -what stock to buy
- Technicals
 - when to buy or sell
- News
 - overrides all fundamental and technical analysis



Technical Analysis

The study of a chart for purposes of determining trends, patterns and projections

Technical Analysis

- □ Price Chart Look at chart
- Overall Trend / Moving Average
- Current Trend
- □ Support and Resistance
- Coval Indicator
- MACD's
- Volume
- Candlesticks





Pay Attention to Trend

- Trend is the direction of trading
- Trade with the trend
- If the preceding trend has been down, look for any reversal patterns to confirm new uptrend before entering a bullish trade

Cash Flow Mentoring



30-Day Moving Average

- The moving average represents trend
- •If price breaks <u>above</u> the 30 DMA, indicates that the stock is now stronger than it has been on average in the past
- This can be used as an entry point for a bullish intermediate-term trend trade in combination with other technical analysis tools

Coval Indicator

- Shows short term moves in price action
- Measures buying and selling prices
- Above the zero line is stronger
- ·Below the zero line is weaker
- Can be over overbought or oversold for a while

MACD

Moving Average Convergence Divergence

Take 2 moving averages, one short term and one long term

Visually tells us if a stock is overbought or oversold

A Nobel Prize winning calculation invented in 1979



Volume

- •Shows overall interest in the stock
- Each bar is that day's total buy/sell volume
- •Green is an up day
- •Red is a down day
- •High volume is 150% of average
- •High volume confirms a breakout .vs fake out
- ·Low volume could signal a reversal

Why Add Options?

•Leverage your investment, very little money at risk (how do you buy your house?)



- ·Can provide Growth
- •Can use them for Cash Flow (income)
- Trade any market direction



Why Trade Options?

- Less capital
- Limited risk
- Potential higher rate of return
- Multiple strategies
- Great for neutral markets
- Peace of mind

What's in an Option Contract?

- Stock symbol
- •Buy or sell
- Contract shares
- Strike price
- Expiration date





Selling Options

Selling a call option

Someone pays you money



For the right to buy your stock

It is their choice to buy or not



If it moves above the strike price they will buy

If it does not, then they will not buy your stock

Basic Options: Call or Put

Buy a Call if you think the stock will move higher



Buy a Put if you think the stock will head lower





Where Can This Be Done?

- Brokerage account
- Retirement account
- Custodial Account
- About 10-20 minutes per day
- Technical analysis and trade discipline are extremely important for option trading
